

Foreign nationals staying in India on long-term visas (such as student, employment, research, or medical visas) are required to register and comply with FRRO (Foreigners Regional Registration Office) guidelines.

### When is FRRO Registration Required?

- Stay exceeding 180 days
- Employment, Student, or Research visa holders
- Visa extension, exit permit, or change of address
- Foreigners staying with Indian host families or hotels

### Documents Typically Required

- Valid passport and visa
- Passport-size photograph (recent)
- Proof of residence in India (rental agreement, hotel receipt)
- C-Form or RP Form (for students or hosted guests)
- Supporting documents like employment letter or admission letter
